Principal

Study Hours

The following hours of the day are set aside for serious study: 6.30 pm to 8.00 pm and 9.00pm – 11.00 pm. These study hours must be gone through in complete silence and in one's own room. An atmosphere of silence must prevail in the hostel from 9.00 pm in the evening to 7.00 am in the morning. Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited during study/silence hours.

All hostellers are expected to be present in their respective rooms during these hours, during which the roll-call may be taken at any time at the discretion of the warden. Only with the written permission of the Warden may any hosteller stay out of the hostel beyond 6.30 pm.

General Norms

1. Every hosteller is responsible for her own belongings as well as for the furniture, fixtures and furnishings in the room provided to her. She shall keep her room neat and tidy. The warden is entitled to open any of the rooms for inspection at any time.
2. Use of electrical appliances (stove, heaters, boilers etc.) is not permitted in the room. Setting up any additional fixtures in the room requires the explicit permission of the Warden.
3. Hostellers, who skip classes in the college without the permission of the Warden and the Principal, are liable to be expelled from the hostel. Those who fail in selection/university examinations or successive semester examinations forfeit their hostel seat.
4. The use of tobacco (in any form), alcohol and drugs are strictly forbidden. Anyone found indulging in them is liable to be summarily dismissed.
5. Anyone who spends the night outside the hostel without the written permission of the Warden and the Local Guardian will be summarily dismissed.
6. No meetings of any nature, except those called together by the warden or permitted by the warden may be held in the hostel premises by anyone or any organization.
7. In addition to these general norms, the Rector/Principal/Warden may issue additional rules or orders at any time for the better management of the hostel. Every hosteller shall be bound by them.

Please Note: Don Bosco hostels are known round the country for their dedicated service to college students by providing them with an atmosphere of serious study, character formation, religious orientation and other programmes aimed at an integral formation of young persons in the spirit and philosophy of Don Bosco. Should anyone feel that the rules are too much of a burden, let her/him not apply for residence in the college hostel.
